This Thanksgiving, members of the Willmar FFA Chapter, and the turkeys they raised, were given the opportunity of a lifetime. For Willmar FFA members Brianna Hoover, Brenna Ahlquist, Val Brown and Preston Asche this was the opportunity to travel to Washington D.C. and participate in a Thanksgiving tradition at the White House. For the turkeys selected, named Liberty and Peace, this was the opportunity to receive a pardon by President Obama and be saved from the fate of most turkeys during the Thanksgiving season.

The participating FFA members worked with the birds for an hour every day after school. In addition to cleaning their pen and equipment, the FFA members got the flock comfortable around humans and distraction by talking, making random noise, playing music, and lifting each bird onto a table. 
